Eureka Springs City Advertising and Promotion Commission Announces Open Seat

Mike Maloney, Executive Director of the Eureka Springs City Advertising and Promotion Commission has announced an opening on the City Advertising and Promotion Commission (CAPC) effective immediately.

“ This is the open chair position, of which there is only one that enables any adult resident of Carroll County with an interest/background in tourism to sit on the CAPC Commission. This is position # 8, which does expire June 30, 2018, so this seat is to fill out the term of the previous Commissioner, Charles Ragsdell, who has resigned.”

Individuals for the open seat must reside in Carroll County and be a qualified elector. It is the best interests of the Commission that the applicant be involved in some capacity in the tourism industry. The Commission will review the applicants based upon their tourism background and the overall contributions they may be able to make during their service. The Commission will select an individual who, in their opinion, will make the most outstanding contributions to the Commission. Then, the prospective Commissioner must receive approval from the Eureka Springs City Council and then be sworn in.
